Car Parking at the Cemetery.

Cllr Phillips reported back from his meeting with the owners of a vehicle parked in one of the spots and of the building materials left in the other spot. He advised that the materials had been moved leaving one place clear. The sign asking people to leave space for visitors/funeral hearses has disappeared. The ownership of Duncannon Lane is still unclear as is the rights to park in that part of the lane. Cllr Hawkins volunteered to contact DCC highways to clarify.

Cllr Evans reported back on the Cluster Meeting of Local parish representatives he attended recently with the Clerk - the Clerk will forward the minutes to the

Dog Fouling This continues to be a problem particularly on Ash Meadow despite the fact that dogs are banned from the meadow. Anyone found to breaking the law will be reported to SHDC with a recommendation that action be taken and those responsible fined. Dog mess can be injurious to health particularly young children.

Bow Hill/Bow Bridge

The condition of the road surface has been reported to DCC - work to improve the surface has now been scheduled - please see noticeboards for details.. The same applies to the damaged bridge.

County Councillor Report.

A plaque at Tuckenhay celebrating the planting of the Coronation Plot is thought to be in Tuckenhay - Mr Peter Wheeler, knows of its whereabouts. Cllr Green will approach Mr Patrick Cox, Terry Collins and Mr Wheeler to arrange for the plaque to be erected on the plot.
