1781/20/CLP R.Peeke, Granary Farm, Washbourne. Certificate of Lawfulness - 1 Caravan. Proposed Certificate of Lawfulness - Certified by SHDC.

4062/19/HHO Brant. Butterwell Cottage. Approval of materials only re. existing application. Discharge of Condition approved by SHDC

0376/20/TCA C. Bow. Orchard Linhay. Field maple - fell due to impact to retaining wall adjacent to highway and interference to overhead cables. No objection SHDC.

2298/20/TEX Matthias Schlueter 10 Holly Villas. Exemption granted by SHDC to fell T1 Sycamore {5 stems} -5 day notice to fell , dangerous, x5 co-dominant stems, central stem snapped and leaning against adjacent summer house. Reason Dead or dangerous. Condition that tree be replaced with 1 x Tilia x europaea 8-10cm Girth Selected Standard which is to be planted as close as practically possible to where the tree was removed.
